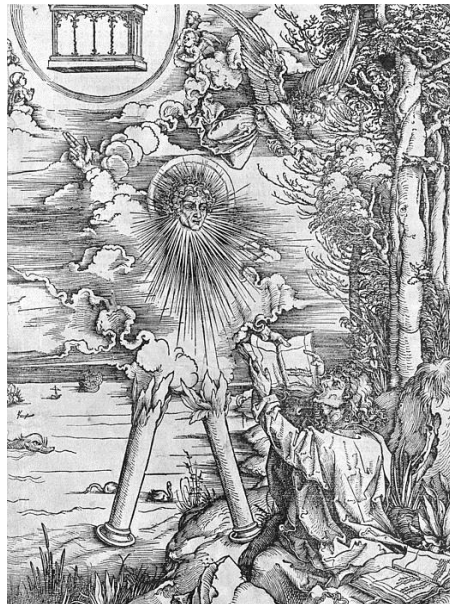

FROM FUNDRAISING...

MALERBO CONCESSION STAND - The Town of Burlington has again awarded us the privilege of operating the concession stand at the Malerbo soccer fields next to Lake Garda Elementary school for the 2019 Spring and Fall soccer seasons. This is one of our top fundraisers and grants us the joy of interacting with our community families and visitors and showcase our wonderful congregation! We operate the stand during the BJSA (Burlington Junior Soccer Association) games on Saturday mornings from 9am-1pm. Come volunteer an hour or two sometime during the seasons - it is a guaranteed FUN time! The Spring season starts April 27 and likely ends on June 22. No games Memorial Day weekend.

CAN AND BOTTLE DRIVES - We are hoping to resume these in March or April, but we are dependent on ensuring we find a redemption center that can handle our collection volume. We believe we have one secured but will need to confirm with them before setting a date. In the meantime, if you have cans and bottles piling up, consider taking some of them to the grocery store and placing those redemption dollars in the Sunday service collection plate in an envelope marked "Fundraising - Can & Bottle Drive".

Gulf gas gift cards no longer accepted at Cumberland Farms: I was made aware that the Gulf cards no longer work at the pumps at Cumby's. I inquired with the company and they responded that they split with Gulf Oil at the end of 2017, and since then have been updating their card processors across their locations so will no longer be accepting Gulf credit cards or gift cards. Therefore, I will not be ordering Gulf cards as I know those of you who used them mostly went to the Burlington Cumby's. There are Gulf stations in the area you can use your cards at; however, if you think you will not be able to use your Gulf cards, I will be happy to exchange your unused \$25 cards for another retailer's \$25 card. - Maryann
